

Wealth of Knowledge

The DmbHIMShas a spacious library and open to students and staff members from 09:30 a.m. to 05:30 p.m. on all working days. The library has rich collection of 705 Nos. of titles and 4289 Nos. of volumes of text and reference books. The library has subscription of 254 pharmaceutical journals. Previous journals issues were preserved for future referencing. There are separate sections of library viz. reprographic facility, stacking/referencearea, journals section and spacious reading hall. All the books are segregated subject wise and shelved in the suitable labelled cupboards. Koha software is integrated as library automation management software. On line platform OPAC facility is provided to find out the access of books and journals in the library by the students.







Campus Facilities

Class room

The class rooms are well ventilated, airy and spacious and are fitted with sufficient fans. Each class rooms have enough windows to maintain horizontal flow of air from one side to another side. The window panes are fitted with glass films for light adjustment. The classrooms are painted with light colors. The sufficient numbers of benches with desks are provided to accommodate 60 students in a class. Each class room of the institution is equipped with required academic aids for engaging the students in their academic activities. The class room of the institution is designed to get unhindered view of the faculty members and teaching aids from all sides.



Laboratories

DmbH Institute of Medical Science provides state-of-art laboratory facilities for enhancing conducive teaching – learning and research culture. The institution makes available sufficient infrastructure, equipments, computing facility as per requirements of various apex bodies like PCI, MAKAUT, WBSCT&VE&SD to enhance the practical skills of the students and always upgrade it as necessary. Total 12 laboratories with adjacent preparation rooms are available in three floors in the institution. In addition, Central Instrumentation room, Machine room and Aseptic room are also furnished with well equipped sophisticated instruments and pilot scale machinery generally available in pharmaceutical industries. All amenities / utilities such as gas supplies (compressed LPG, water) are provided maintaining all safety norms and 24×7 power supply are available in laboratories.The special attentions have been given on safety of students through installation of safety measure devices and fuming cupboard for handing of hazardous chemicals during experiments.

- Aqua guard RO system chilled water is provided for drinking purpose.
- The mess with large sitting capacity provides nutritious and delicious food at reasonable rate.
